

City of Laddonia

The City of Laddonia has decided to regrade ditches throughout the town in 2024. The ditch work will begin April 15th and continue till August 16th. Ditch surveying and culvert inspection has taken place.

Due to Laddonia's rainwater drainage issues, LPW will be re-grading the ditches to alleviate the issue. Culverts on residential properties will be inspected and LPW will inform the property owner if LPW recommends that a culvert be replaced.

Laddonia Public Works has broken down the city streets into weeks. Meaning, each street will have a designated week to be worked on. (see attached schedule) Both sides of the street will be re-graded.

Before the start of this project, LPW would like to compile a list of residents that need or would like a culvert installed on their property.

LPW intends to put in the residential driveway culverts during this ditch re-grading process. Resident's culvert will be installed according to their street's week. This will streamline the process and ensure everyone that wants a new driveway culvert installed has the time to purchase one and have it ready for LPW to install.

If you are interested in having a new culvert installed, please contact City Hall with your name and address to be put on the schedule.

Also, if you have any questions about this process or would like advice about what kind of culvert or size culvert you'll need, please contact City Hall. If you also would like the dirt that is removed from the ditches in front of your property, residents are welcome to it. Please let LPW know.

The city does not and cannot buy or order residential culverts. It is the resident's responsibility to purchase their own culverts to be installed.

Please Note: This is a schedule and method LPW intends to use as a guide.
These dates may vary depending on weather conditions, other operations that may take precedence, or emergencies.
